

Communication Evaluation

TESTING STANDARDS COMMUNICATION

The purpose of this evaluation is to ensure that each member participating in Communication training has achieved the minimum set of skills. The evaluation consists of a member sending and receiving message via a radio and completing all required ICS/NMSAR forms. Responsibility for running evaluations falls to the President.

1. Evaluator Instructions:

- a. Provide the member with a completed ICS or NMSAR form 205, Communication Plan.
- b. Provide the member with a blank NMSAR 214 (Unit Log), NMSAR 310 (Communication Log), and NMSAR 314 (Resource Tracking Worksheet).
- c. Provide member with the mission scenario.
- d. Provide member with a written message to send to a team via a voice radio transmission.
- e. Send the member a message via a radio transmission.
- f. No member will be considered to have demonstrated minimal proficiency without having: sent accurate messages; accurately recorded incoming messages; completed all necessary NMSAR form entries for received and sent messages; and provide a completed NMSAR 214 (Unit Log), NMSAR 310 (Communication Log), and NMSAR 314 (Resource Tracking Worksheet) to the evaluator.

2. Evaluation:

- a. Candidate will make an entry on their NMSAR 214, Unit Log, when they received their assignment brief, and when their radio equipment is ready, and they are prepared to perform duties as a radio operator.
- b. Candidate will send a voice message (provided in writing, by the evaluator) to a team.
- c. Candidate will receive (via a radio transmission) a message and record the received message on the NMSAR 310, Communication Log and the NMSAR 314, Resource Tracking Worksheet.
- d. Candidate will ensure all NMSAR forms are completed and provide the completed NMSAR forms to the evaluator when requested.
